

Department of literature theory and literary relations

Departments and sections - the theory of literature, literary relations, theory of translation, Russian literature in Uzbekistan over the past 45 years and led its activities independently and jointly.

Department of translation theory (head Zh.Sh.Sharipov): Department of studying Russian literature of Uzbekistan until 1985 headed by Prof.. M.M.Rasuli, in 1986-1996 yy. supervised PhD P.Mirzaahmedova.

Department of literary connections (for many years headed the corresponding member of the Academy of Sciences of Uzbekistan Yu.S.Sultonov. Then the head of department were prof. H.Sh.Abdusamatov, acad. S.M.Mamajonov, prof. E.A.Karimov), who organized the department "Theory of literature and literary criticism" in the mid 60th years of XX century. At the end of the last century of the above departments merged into one department. Keeping the lines of research department has been called "Theory of literature and literary relations". Currently, the department is heading by academician B.A.Nazarov. Features, place of literature in the arts and distinctive similarities with other forms of art.

The emergence of literature and trends in the historical development of the system and the literary genres and genres; the social nature of literature, the content and form, the structure of a work of art, literary process and the psychology of creativity; aesthetic categories in the literature;

Versification and poetic system; literary trends and directions, the synthesis of art and other creative methods and theoretical issues are just objects of study of the theory of literature.

Therefore, the study of patterns of literary-theoretical problems existing in national literature are the task of the national literature, in particular, the theory of literature.
